*in Recognition and Celebration of*  
**Developmental Disabilities Awareness**  
**Month**

**WHEREAS**, Developmental Disabilities Awareness Month is an opportunity to promote respect for people with developmental disabilities. This year’s theme, “Embracing Diverse Communities Together” highlights our appreciation of the contributions people with developmental disabilities make and our recognition of their vital and vibrant roles in our island community as they improve the quality of life everyone who calls Guam home.

The Guam Developmental Disabilities Council is involved in advocating for programs that promote positive system changes that allow individuals with developmental disabilities to achieve optimum independence and to promote innovative programs and practices that improve the quality of life for these individuals. The council encourages all Guamanians to actively participate in events that appropriately recognize and celebrate Guam’s culturally diverse population, including individuals with developmental disabilities.

Developmental Disabilities Awareness Month promotes awareness and understanding of the opportunities, challenges and needs of persons with developmental disabilities. It recognizes Guam’s public policy accomplishments concerning individuals with developmental disabilities.
